Learn how your kids can participate

For the third consecutive year, Allentown children can receive a free lunch through the Lehigh Valley Hospital-17th Street Summer Meals program for kids. Morrison Healthcare, a Lehigh Valley Health Network food services partner, is assisting with providing the healthy meals, which typically include a sandwich, a piece of fruit and milk.

To participate, children must be 18 or younger and in Allentown. No registration is required, and no personal information is collected.

COVID-19 safety

Lunches are “grab and go” in compliance with U.S. Department of Agriculture and CDC guidelines for safe food handling. Caregivers can pick up lunches on behalf of their children; likewise, children can pick up lunches without a caregiver present.

This program is funded through a grant from the U.S. Department of Agriculture’s Summer Food Program, a federally funded program administered through the Pennsylvania Department of Education.
